Tips to Save on Your Utility Bills

- 1 Change your air filter.
- 2 Adjust your thermostat while you are out of the house.
- 3 Keep windows covered in the summer, and uncovered in the winter.
- 4 Insulate your water heater.
- 5 Wash your clothes on cold.
- 6 Use energy efficient lightbulbs and appliances.
- 7 Run your appliances outside of peak hours (after 10pm).
- 8 Take shorter showers, and use less hot water. Use a water efficient showerhead.
